Supa Fresh CSA, 2017

Community Supported Agriculture (CSAs) are a great way to buy delicious, sustainably-grown, fresh, local & seasonal food directly from the farmer.

Every Dollar helps empower local youth. CSA proceeds are used to pay the farmers & to purchase essential tools & supplies for the farms.

CSAs are a great way to learn about new types of vegetables & try new recipes. They encourage you to cook healthy foods while enjoying seasonal bounty.

Members get delicious, fresh, seasonal vegetables, herbs, berries, flowers, and more; plus they get the satisfaction of empowering local youth to succeed.

Full Share \$500

Feeds 2-4 people

Weekly pick-up

Weekly share for one family or household of 2-4 people, depending on overall vegetable consumption.

Half Share \$250

Feeds 1-3 people

Two Options:

- 1) Full-size share for 8 weeks, Every other week pick-up
- 2) Half-size share for 16 weeks Weekly pick-up

Split share \$500

Feeds 2-4 people

Alternate weekly pick-up

Weekly share split between two families or households on alternating weeks.

Total cost per week = \$31.25 Ask us about payment plans!

SCHEDULE & PICK-UP INFORMATION

WHEN: *Day/Dates TBD, 4:00-6:00pm, June through September

**Pick up day & start/end dates to be determined by spring, 2017*

WHERE: The Bethlehem House of Bread, 9055 SW Locust Street, Tigard

Shares not picked up by 6:00pm will be distributed to the farmers or food pantry, unless other arrangements have been made for after-hours pick up. To arrange for after-hours pick up or to change your pick up time (24 hour notice required) please contact Katrin at 503-307-0633. If you are running late to pick up please let us know and we will set your share aside in a cooler for a later pick

MEMBER AGREEMENT:

Members should be aware of the inherent risks of farming, that there is no way of knowing what the nature of each growing season will bring; they should be willing to share the risk and reap the benefits along with the farmers. Members are responsible for picking up their shares at the pickup site during the designated time period, or to send someone in their absence; otherwise their share will be donated to the Bethlehem House of Bread Food Pantry or one of the youth farmers. Members must provide a minimum notice of 24 hours if they need to cancel or reschedule their pick-up, and they must understand that the ability to reschedule a pick-up is (usually) limited to the operating hours of the farm (Tuesday - Friday).

FARMER AGREEMENT:

Supa Fresh Farmers will provide each CSA member with quality, seasonal produce, including a diverse range of vegetables, herbs, berries and flowers, grown using organic techniques. The farmers will process produce in ways that keep our members and their families safe, and that will make preparing them easier. The farmers will make every effort to contact CSA members who are late/forgot to pick up their shares, in order to get them their produce before donating unclaimed shares. The farmers will keep members informed and up-to-date with weekly news, recipes and information on their CSA boxes in the youth-generated newsletter and blog. The farmers will provide excellent service to members as well as include them in celebrations, activities and events at the farm. The program staff will assist youth farmers to ensure members receive excellent produce and service, while also providing the youth with mentoring, employment training, and the opportunity to develop the skills and experience that will help them be successful in life.

The Supa Fresh Youth Farm is committed to fostering a healthy, connected community around local food and does so, in part, by offering CSA members and their families opportunities to participate in farm activities and events. We encourage CSA members to visit the farm, meet the farmers, join us in our work, and celebrate with us.
